

Nantucket Blue Hydrangea



Selected for prolific blooming, vibrant bloom color and compact growth habit, this repeat blooming Hydrangea features an abundance of summertime flower clusters until frost.

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Nantucket Blue'

- **Use:** A great new Hydrangea and is a repeat blooming selection of the renowned Bigleaf Hydrangea that adorns houses on the island of Nantucket. Unlike most Hydrangeas, this unique beauty blooms repeatedly on new growth throughout the growing season and may bloom from early summer well into early fall.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Morning sun and afternoon shade (Partial sun is best) DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN! (In full sun they wilt constantly in our hot summer heat and leaf burn) Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. Depending on soil pH, you can have vivid rose-pink or purple hydrangea flower heads.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 4-6 feet high; 4-6' width in only 4 years.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large leaves offer a lush backdrop for the showy blossoms Mildew resistant foliage.
- **Flower:** An abundant summertime display of blue or pink mophead clusters that rebloom on new wood and last until frost. These Hydrangeas are pH-sensitive and will change color depending on the acidity or alkalinity of your soil. It is best to sweeten the soil with lime to turn the blooms pink. Or acidify the soil to intensify the blue!
