

Limelight Prime Hydrangea



Hydrangea paniculata 'Limelight Prime'

- **Use:** Here's how Limelight Prime hydrangea is different:
 - *Blooms much earlier, creating a longer display.
 - *Bolder, brighter color. As the green blooms age, they develop pink and red tones that are far more vivid and showy than conventional panicle hydrangeas.
 - *Stronger stems useful smaller size.
- **Exposure/Soil:** It thrives in morning sun afternoon shade, but also tolerates heat and humidity. **DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN!**
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to a very garden- and landscape-friendly 4-6' tall and 4-5' wide. To prune, simply cut back by one-third of its total height every spring.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Darker, healthier-looking foliage, stronger stems, and a more compact growth habit.
- **Flower:** The blooms emerge a vivid lime green and maintain that color longer, often until they transition into a bubblegum pink. The blooms eventually finish a rich, punch pink. It makes a better-looking container, and finishes just as quickly as 'Limelight'.

Most impressive when planted in a large row of 5+ plants
