

Little Quick Fire Hydrangea



This dwarf plant fits easily into any landscape, including container gardens. Add it to your existing hydrangea garden to extend the hydrangea season.

Hydrangea paniculata 'Little Quick Fire'

- **Use:** This dwarf form of Quick Fire fits easily into any landscape. Use it in a mixed border, or as a showy specimen or foundation plant. Its early bloom time will extend your garden's hydrangea season.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. They do not like wet areas or extremely dry ones - your soil should be rich and moist for optimal growth. Blooms on new wood.
- **Growth:** Grows 3-5 feet high; equal width in only 3 –4 years.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Coarse shrub with large lobed foliage and exfoliating bark. Reddish brown fall color.
- **Flower:** It is early blooming, flowering about a month before other hydrangeas. White flowers transform to pink-red as summer progresses.
