
Quick Fire® Panicle Hydrangea





Blooms on this super •
-hardy and easy to
grow hydrangea are
produced on new
wood, which means

the harshest winters. Beautiful for use as a cut (fresh or dried) flower. Unlike other panicle hydrangeas, Quick Fire also has excellent fall foliage color for a final hurrah before winter.

Hydrangea paniculata 'Bulk' PP16812

- <u>Use</u>: Quick Fire® hydrangea blooms about a month before any other panicle hydrangea. Flowers open pure white then turn pink(with cold nites in late fall). The flower color on Quick Fire hydrangea is not affected by soil pH.
 - **Exposure/Soil:** Partial sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. They do not like wet areas or extremely dry ones your soil should be rich and moist for optimal growth. Blooms on new wood.
- Growth: Grows 8 feet high; equal width in only 3 –4 years.
- Hardiness: Zone 3-8 Shrub
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Coarse shrub with large lobed foliage and exfoliating bark. Gold and burgundy fall color.
- <u>Flower:</u> It is early blooming, flowering about a month before other hydrangeas. White flowers transform to pink-red as summer progresses. The intensity of the pink is determined by cold nights.
