

# Silver Dollar Hydrangea



**Makes a great cut flower and dries easily, giving you gorgeous fresh cuts in summer and rich floral displays in fall and winter.**

## ***Hydrangea paniculata 'Silver Dollar'***

- **Use:** This small but mighty beauty blooms with full-sized flowers in a more compact form than you'd expect from a hydrangea.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Preferably grows in part sun. It shouldn't be allowed to dry out so the soil needs to be kept moist. **DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN UNLESS YOU HAVE IRRIGATION!** In full sun some leaf burn in August is normal due to heat. It is best to apply thick mulch around the plant to protect it in exposed locations or colder zones.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 4-5 feet high; equal width in only 3–4 years.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large, glossy, dark-green leaves.
- **Flower:** In mid-summer through fall it covers itself in dense trusses of lacy, creamy-white blooms held upright on strong stems. The whole effect is romantic and nostalgic. Flowers can be dried.
