

Strawberry Sundae Hydrangea



The flowers continue well into fall in most areas, and are, as you can imagine, spectacular in fresh and dried arrangements.

Hydrangea paniculata 'Rensun' PPAF

- **Use:** Although the colorful flowers resemble those of Vanilla Strawberry™, this compact new selection by the same breeder grows only 4-5' tall. The blossoms evolve in similar fashion as the season progresses, from creamy white to pink to red. An award-winning variety that provides an easy way to add color to small spaces. **Try it in the border, the foundation, the woodland garden, or even as a specimen. You will be amazed at its beauty and ever-changing interest.**
- **Exposure/Soil:** Afternoon or dappled shade preferred. Easy to grow in continuously moist, well-drained soil. Butterflies will visit it, and it is very low maintenance, asking only for adequate water. **DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN**, unless you want to see leaf burn and water constantly!
- **Growth:** Large, well-branched, and vigorous, reaches 4 to 5 feet high and 4 to 5 feet wide within just a few seasons.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Handsome bright, green foliage on boldly branched, mounded form.
- **Flower:** Flowers emerge creamy white in mid summer, change to pink and finally to strawberry red. The flowers will remind you of a refreshing strawberry sundae ice cream treat on a hot summer afternoon.
