

# Oakleaf Hydrangea 'Alice'

## *Hydrangea quercifolia* 'Alice'

- **Use:** For the shrub border this bold selection is very handsome.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Prune to ground in early spring; becomes 8 to 10 ft. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. An added bonus, foliage turns brilliant crimson in fall. It has deeply lobed, oak-like leaves.
- **Flower:** A profusion of large white blooms. Showy, creamy white blooms in summer.
