

Autumn Reprise™ Hydrangea



Re-Blooming • Versatile Plant
• Burgundy Fall Foliage
It flowers beautifully in shade and the white flowers certainly brighten up dark areas.

- **Use:** Keep your garden gorgeous spring through fall! The crisp green foliage transitions through shades of plum and royal burgundy in cooler seasons. Pollinator-friendly white flowers offer impressive re-blooming. Native to North America with excellent disease resistance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial sun (morning sun and afternoon shade preferred). Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. a dramatic, white-blooming shrub with four seasons of interest. A tremendous advantage of the Oakleaf is that it can thrive in much dryer locations than its cousins. Mopheads struggle in my sandy soil, but the Oakleaf hydrangeas thrive with very little attention.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 5 to 6 feet high; equal width in only 3 –4 years.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Green foliage is quilted with pointed lobed leaves! Then they transform into gorgeous burgubdy in the fall.
- **Flower:** White and green flowers bloom in cone-shaped clusters during the summer and fall.
