

Ellen Huff Oakleaf Hydrangea



Hydrangea quercifolia 'Ellen Huff'

- **Use:** This shrub is a showcase of earth tones. Its 8 in. long panicles of white flowers, which later take on a pinkish hue, stand out like snow against the beautiful cinnamon-brown, exfoliating bark and the large dark green Oak-like leaves that turn reddish purple in autumn.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. **DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN!**
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 4 to 6 feet high; equal width in only 3 –4 years.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Handsome foliage on boldly branched, mounded form. Prune right after flowering if necessary.
- **Flower:** Blooms July–August.
