Hydrangea quercifolia ‘Gatsby Gal’

- **Use:** Great back of the border shrub or a splendid foundation plant. The graceful white blooms look good with almost any type of landscape, making this a very versatile addition to your garden. This is already a tidy plant, but it takes pruning well if you need it even tighter. Selected from a breeding program designed to produce interesting flower forms, these remarkably full blossoms open creamy white, and turn to rosy pink in fall. Plants are relatively compact, and create an impressive show all season long.
- **Exposure/Soil:** It thrives in morning sun afternoon shade, but also tolerates heat and humidity. DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN!
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 5-6 feet high; equal width in only 3 –4 years.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large, glossy, dark-green leaves.
- **Flower:** This flamboyant beauty boasts massive flower heads, boldly sculpted leaves with brilliant fall color, and handsome peeling bark.
