## *Hydrangea quercifolia* 'Gatsby Pink'

- **Use:** A blushing beauty all summer long! The tall bloom wands boast exceptionally large, nodding florets dyed a rich pink color. The lush oak leaves keep the shrub pretty all season long, taking on tinges of Burgundy when fall rolls around. This North American native is perfect for woodland gardens and informal plantings.
- **Exposure/Soil:** It thrives in morning sun afternoon shade, but also tolerates heat and humidity. **DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN!**
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 6-8 feet high; equal width in only 3 –4 years. Blooms on old growth, so it is recommended that they be trimmed after they are finished flowering in the late summer.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Handsome dark green foliage turns burgundy-red in autumn.
- **Flower:** Boasts big, showy blooms that quickly transform from pure white to a glorious pink, providing months of color.
