Loose, carefree habit lends itself beautifully to mass plantings and use in pollinator-friendly gardens. It also creates new uses for all kinds of spaces, such as hanging baskets and cascading containers, and spilling over rocks and wall spaces.

We're confident you'll love its unique horizontal growing habit, with each trailing stem absolutely brimming with blooms. Its summer borne florets are filled with deckle-edged petals, bringing a frilly, lacey look to the landscape. There are no limits to the ways you can use Fairytrail Bride™ in the garden - it's ready to wow your neighbors in hanging baskets, containers, cascading over retaining walls, and filling in mixed beds!
- **Exposure/Soil:** We recommend a minimum of six hours of sun for the strongest stems and the most abundant flowers. In hot climates, afternoon shade is beneficial, but some sun is still recommended for the best results.
- **Growth:** It grows to 4' tall and as wide. Avoid pruning except to remove any dead wood. These hydrangeas cannot be cut back or trimmed at any time of the year without impacting the bloom for either the current season or the next. Though they do rebloom readily on new wood, the best display comes from treating them as though they bloom only old wood. It allows any ice crystals on the plant to melt away very gradually, reducing the risk of tissue damage. Protecting them with old blankets on those spring nights and mornings when unusually cold weather threatens is also a viable approach.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7a-9b; Shrub Because they bloom so much earlier in the season than other hydrangeas, their flower buds are more susceptible to damage from unexpected spring frosts and freezes. To combat this, we have found that planting them in sites where they are shaded in the morning is very helpful.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Medium green foliage.
- **Flower:** Long, trailing stems draped in white lace, with a bouquet of florets at every leaf node, yields a dramatic display from late spring to fall.
