

# Golden Hoogendorn™ Holly



## *Ilex crenata* 'Golden Hoogendoorn' PPAF

- **Use:** New brilliantly golden-yellow leaves emerge in spring to brighten the landscape. Golden Hoogendorn™ Holly is a low-growing, dense evergreen shrub with small rounded leaves and good cold-hardiness. Its golden color fades in shade and during summer. Excellent landscape specimen. Very reminiscent of boxwood. An elegant choice for use in shrub borders, as a low hedge or in mass plantings. Has impressive cold hardiness.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun-part shade. Well-drained soil, not soggy. Water the 1st two years for best growth. If it doesn't rain for 7-10 days, then water. For fastest growth use slow release fertilizer two times a year!
- **Growth:** Mature size is 3 to 4 feet tall and 4 to 5 feet wide. Very strong and easy to grow!.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Small, rounded golden foliage, but will lose color in deep shade or during extreme summer heat, but fear not as the golden color will return..
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
