Ilex crenata 'Helleri'

- **Use:** It makes an excellent evergreen foundation planting under windows, as a low hedge, or as an evergreen background for bulbs and flowering perennials.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part shade. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Water if it hasn't rained in 2 weeks.
- **Growth:** This is a low growing, spreading variety of Japanese Holly with a dwarf mounding habit spreading up to 5' in width, but only reaching a maximum of 3' in height.
- **Hardiness:** 6-8, shrub
- **Foliage:** Small green leaves. Evergreen.
- **Flower:** Not known for small white flowers. Small, black berries not very visible either.
