Variegated Heller's Holly



Best known for use as planting under windows up near the home.

- <u>Use:</u> It makes an excellent evergreen foundation planting under windows, as a low hedge, or as an evergreen background for bulbs and flowering perennials.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun to part shade. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Water if it hasn't rained in 2 weeks.
- **Growth:** This is a low growing, spreading variety of Japanese Holly with a dwarf mounding habit spreading up to 5' in width, but only reaching a maximum of 3' in height.
- Hardiness: 6-8, shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen. Green and yellow foliage adds a splash of color to the garden.
- *Flower:* Not known for small white flowers. Small, black berries not very visible either.
