Ilex vomitoria 'Hightower'

- **Use:** An elegant multi-trunked tree that can be a striking accent plant. Fantastic for use as a striking specimen plant. Drought tolerant. Very easy to grow and maintain. **Native-parents of this new cultivar are natives to the Southeast.**
- **Exposure/Soil:** Best in full sun, but will grow in partial shade. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Water if it hasn't rained in 2 weeks.
- **Growth:** Small tree that can grow 20' tall and 10' wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Has stiff branches and grey stems with small shiny, bright red fruit.
- **Flower:** It is a true holly, with small white flowers in spring that mature into red berries by the fall or winter. Female cultivar.
