

# Folsom's Weeping Yaupon Holly



## *Ilex vomitoria* 'Pendula'

- **Use:** An elegant multi-trunked tree that can be a striking accent plant. Fantastic for use as a striking specimen plant. Drought tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part shade. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Water if it hasn't rained in 2 weeks.
- **Growth:** Small tree that can grow 8' to 15' tall, but only 4' to 6' wide with a weeping form.
- **Hardiness:** 6-8, shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Has stiff branches and grey stems with small shiny, bright red fruit.
- **Flower:** It is a true holly, with small white flowers in spring that mature into red berries by the fall or winter. As with the true hollies, individual plants are either male or female – and only the female plants will bear berries.
