Folsom's Weeping Yaupon Holly



llex vomitoria 'Pendula'

- <u>Use</u>: An elegant multi-trunked tree that can be a striking accent plant. Fantastic for use as a striking specimen plant. Drought tolerant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun to part shade. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Water if it hasn't rained in 2 weeks.
- <u>Growth</u>: Small tree that can grow 8' to 15' tall, but only 4' to 6' wide with a weeping form.
- *Hardiness:* 6-8, shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen. Has stiff branches and grey stems with small shiny, bright red fruit.
- *Flower:* It is a true holly, with small white flowers in spring that mature into red berries by the fall or winter. As with the true hollies, individual plants are either male or female and only the female plants will bear berries.
