

Liberty Holly



Ilex x Conty' /'Liberty'



With its large, serrated leaves and upright, pyramidal form, Liberty™ works well as screening, hedging or as a specimen.

- **Use:** Dense, evergreen shrub with dark lustrous green, deeply serrated leaves that are set along dark stems. In the fall, clusters of bright red berries decorate the foliage. Use in mass plantings or as a hedge to add interest to the landscape. Untrimmed or lightly-trimmed trees usually carry the most berries. Branches can be cut for your home in winter, or to create Christmas wreaths with a unique look.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun-part shade. Well-drained soil, not soggy. Water the 1st two years for best growth. If it doesn't rain for 7-10 days, then water. For fastest growth use slow release fertilizer two times a year!
- **Growth:** Strong growth 12 feet tall and 8 feet wide.
- **Hardiness: Zone** 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. The leaves are large, with striking 'saw-tooth' edges, and they show off the bright orange-red berries beautifully.
- **Flower:** Vivid red fruit in clusters. These appear in fall, and they last all through fall and most of the winter too, before being taken by birds as an important winter food for them.
