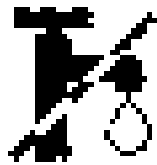


Pink Frost Fragrant Anise



Illicium floridanum 'Pink Frost'

- **Use:** A vigorous shrub for a shady location, Pink Frost has lovely variegated white and green foliage that highlights the maroon-red spring flowers. Variegated foliage turns a beautiful pink-rose in cold weather. It loves to be in moist, but well drained soils. Looks especially good in a container on a shady porch or patio. New selection of Florida anise comes from Mickey Harp of Fayetteville Georgia, who discovered it as a branch sport. *Illicium* 'Pink Frost' is a dramatic improvement over the crinkly-leaf *Illicium* 'Shady Lady'.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grows well in sun or shade, but thins out in the shade. Prefers rich soil and ample moisture but will easily survive harsher conditions. It is an easy to grow, pest-free shrub. Once established it will need watering only during long periods of drought and pruning once a year to maintain its shrub form.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing 6-10 ft. tall, 6-10" wide, but can be kept 4-5' tall and wide easily with pruning.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7b-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Lovely variegated white and green foliage that turns a pretty rose-pink color during the cool season.
- **Flower:** Uniquely shaped dark maroon-red flowers in spring.

Will tolerate damp or dry soils and can be turned into a hedge.
