

Yellow Anise



Illicium parviflora

- **Use:** This shrub has aromatic foliage which smells similar to anise. A native to the South Eastern portion of the country and is more tolerant of sun and dry soil than other *Illiciums* but it can also tolerate damp soils. **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun to shade. Keep surface of soil moist, but not soggy. Provide humus-rich, moist, but well-drained soil for best performance.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing 8-10 ft. tall, 3-4' wide or more.
- **Hardiness:** 3-7 Shrub Evergreen.
- **Foliage:** The leaves are olive green in color.
- **Flower:** The flowers are yellow and have many petals in summer.



Will tolerate damp or dry soils and can be turned into a hedge.
