

Forest Green Anise



Illicium parviflorum 'Forest Green'

- **Use:** Unlike most other *Illicium* cultivars that prefer life on the shady side, we have the Forest Green Anise growing in full sun and full shade and it does equally as well under both exposures! No other anise we've grown does this well in full sun. A native to the South Eastern portion of the country and is more tolerant of sun and dry soil than other *Illiciums* but it can also tolerate damp soils.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun to shade. Keep surface of soil moist, but not soggy. Provide humus-rich, moist, but well-drained soil for best performance.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing 8-12ft. tall, 6-8' wide or more.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 7-10b; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. The leaves are dark olive green in color. The shiny, evergreen foliage has a delightful fragrance reminiscent of root beer with a touch of licorice.
- **Flower:** The flowers are yellow and have many petals in summer.



Will tolerate damp or dry soils and can be turned into a hedge.
