
## Blue Point Juniper Cone









## Juniperus chinensis 'Blue Point'

- <u>Use:</u> A favorite for stately lawn specimens and tall screens. To retain the spiral shape will need sheering. Difficult to keep these in pots without proper care. ALL SALES FINAL so please make sure you have proper location, pot, soil, and irrigation. They will need to be on a drip irrigation system going off 1 time a week minimum year round if not raining and 2x a week in warmer months (maybe more if rootbound)
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Little water needed once established. Do not put in pots against a white house as reflecting light will cook them in summer. Pots will need to be on irrigation and at least 16-20" diameter.
- **Growth:** It is a moderate grower getting up to 12 feet tall and 8 feet wide. Can be kept shorter in pot.
- Hardiness: Zone 4-9 Shrub, small tree
- **Foliage:** An evergreen densely branched, broad pyramid form with glowing blue-green foliage. Maintains form well with little shearing.
- Flower: Not known for flowers.
