Blue Point Juniper



Can grow in a patio planter for 2-3 years and then you can transfer to the garden.

Juniperus chinensis 'Blue Point'

- <u>Use:</u> A favorite for stately lawn specimens and tall screens. Will retain its cone-shaped form well without shearing. This Juniper is a good choice for screening in the landscape as an accent, or in containers for a few years.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** It is a moderate grower getting up to 12 feet tall and 8 feet wide.
- *Hardiness:* 4-9 shrub, small tree
- <u>Foliage</u>: An evergreen densely branched, broad pyramid form with glowing blue-green foliage. Maintains form well with practically no shearing.
- Flower: Not known for flowers.
