Juniper procumbens 'Nana'

- **Use:** One of the best ground-hugging evergreens provides a dense mound of branches that radiate from the center. Its foliage and form is best when left unsheared. Wonderful, low-spreading form makes a superb ground cover, group planting or single specimen.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing to 1 ft. high, 6 to 7 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Dense blue-green foliage gives this selection a handsome appearance. Evergreen.
- **Flower:** No noticeable flowers.
