

# Double Japanese Rose Kerria



## *Kerria japonica* 'Pleniflora'

- **Use:** Upright, deciduous shrub bearing large, double yellow / golden flowers in April into May and may repeat bloom. Very graceful habit of growth. Wildlife loves this shrub. A delightful shrub which is a fine choice for the shrub border or as a specimen for the rear of a border..
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partshade to full sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Feed twice a year with a slow release fertilizer. Prefers slightly acidic well drained soils.
- **Growth:** Upright and bushy, it offers bright green foliage banking its golden mum-like blooms. Can grow up to 10' tall, but may be pruned.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9 Shrub, but can be trained as a vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage is small and neat with serrated edges.
- **Flower:** This selection is remarkable for its very double, 1- to 2-inch, golden yellow flowers, profuse bloom, and vigorous, clean growth. Far superior to other doubles, these upright, bushy plants have bright green stems year-round.

**Blooms resemble button mums and are long-lasting when cut.**
