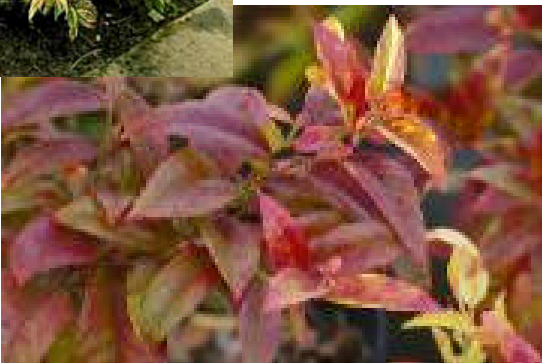


Variegated Coastal Leucothoe



Leucothoe axillaris 'Dodd's Variegated'

- **Use:** It makes an excellent low shrub for shady, well drained areas. The new foliage in the spring is pink and then it becomes variegated over the summer. In the fall it will change colors slightly. It is a great plant for many seasons in the garden. Hard to find!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Low mounding shrub 2-4 feet tall and 4-6' wide. Wide spreading habit with zig-zag branches.
- **Hardiness:** 6 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Dark green, rounded foliage edged in creamy white. Reddish bronze leaves in the winter.
- **Flower:** Fragrant white flower (2.5" long) clusters in spring.
