

Coastal Leucothoe



Leucothoe axillaris 'Margie Jenkins'

- **Use:** Fantastic thick leaves surround this very full plant, but the real treat are the fragrant white blooms in spring. For use in naturalizing, borders with other ericaceous plants, facer plants with taller plants, and shady bank stabilization.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Low mounding shrub 3 feet tall and wide. Wide spreading habit with zig-zag branches.
- **Hardiness:** 6 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Dark green, rounded foliage.
- **Flower:** Fragrant white flower clusters in spring.
