- **Use:** Ditch the typical and embrace the fantastical with Paisley Pup® doghobble. This broadleaf evergreen is native to North America and is filled with eye-catching variegated foliage in shades of pink, green, cream, and bronze. Tiny bell-shaped blooms are strung along arching branches, feeding pollinators in the late springtime. Shade-tolerant, deer-resistant, and low-growing, Paisley Pup solves landscape woes with charm.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part-full shade, moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate growth with a mounding habit of 3-4' tall and 4-5' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Eye-catching variegated foliage in shades of pink, green, cream, and bronze.
- **Flower:** Fragrant, tiny bell-shaped blooms are strung along arching branches, feeding pollinators in the late springtime.
