- **Use:** The gold and green variegated foliage of Good Vibrations® privet will brighten your garden or landscape like a ray of sunshine! You have to see its unique foliage to truly appreciate how vivid it is. Each golden leaf bears a spot of green in its center, and the leaves are arranged irresistibly neatly on the fine branches. It's ideal for an eye-catching specimen or a truly eye-popping hedge. The variegated foliage on Good Vibrations privet makes it quite slow-growing, which means it will be an easy-care plant that won't outgrow its space.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part shade; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Fast grower to 3 to 5 feet tall, 3 to 4 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; This variegation, unlike many other privets, is mostly gold with bright green in the center. Its coloration looks even more cheerful on branches that pop out from the center, like a firework.
- **Flower:** White, fragrant flowers in the spring-summer are sterile.
