

# Cerise Charm™ Fringe Flower



## *Loropetalum chinense* 'Kurobijin' PP23176

- **Use:** Cerise Charm™ is a true breakthrough with dark plum, almost black, small-leaf foliage that doesn't fade. This Loropetalum bears stunning, red flowers in the spring and has graceful, arching branches on a well behaved habit. Use in container on the porch, plant in a group for mass effect
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full (holds color better)– part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Growing to an average size of 3-4' tall wide. Can be kept to a manageable 2-3' tall to use as a foundation plant under windows.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-11, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Intense burgundy-purple foliage year-round with no reversion to green, even in the unforgiving heat of the South-east. After flowering, bright red new leaves emerge that deepen in color as they mature.
- **Flower:** Hot pink fringe flowers in spring-summer blooms are darker than many types on the market. Heaviest flowering in spring, repeating throughout the year.



**Very nice compact, rounded habit and holds the dark foliage color.**
