

Dwarf Pink Jazz Hands Fringe Flower



Uses Notes:
Container gardens, mass plantings, foundation plantings, mixed borders, specimen plant

Loropetalum chinensis 'Jazz Hands Dwarf Pink' ('Kurenai' USPP 27,750)

- **Use:** Jazz Hands Dwarf Pink Loropetalum has cool purple foliage with a cranberry undercurrent. It combines beautifully with the hot pink blooms. This showy little dwarf plant fits easily into residential landscapes and container gardens, and is a great match with Jazz Hands Dwarf White.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full (best leaf color)-part sun. Best in moist, well-drained, acidic soil. Fertilize in spring. Pruning is seldom needed, but may be shaped after flowering. Extra mulch around the base may be helpful in cooler climates.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing 3 to 5 feet tall and 3-5' wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zones** 7-9, shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Foliage becomes bright red in fall.
- **Flower:** Dazzling hot pink fringed flowers illuminate the deep-colored leaves in spring.
