

Jazz Hands Fringe Flower



Loropetalum chinensis 'Jazz Hands Variegated'

- **Use:** Jazz Hands Variegated is the first ever variegated Loropetalum; its new growth is splashed with pink and white variegation, while mature foliage is a rich purple color. This distinctive plant may be used as a specimen or a hedging plant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Full– part sun.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing 4 to 6 feet tall and 4-5'wide.
- **Hardiness: Zones** 7-9, shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. New growth is splashed with pink and white. Mature foliage is purple.
- **Flower:** The emergence of dark fuchsia frilly flowers in spring only add to the excitement this shrub brings to the garden.
