## *Loropetalm chinesis 'Purple Daydream'*

- **Use:** This petite beauty displays dark purple foliage year-round and bursts with lovely pink string clusters each spring. Purple Daydream™ is versatile, handling full sun to part shade, as well as offering drought tolerance and deer resistance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Full– part sun.
- **Growth:** Spreads nicely into a mound reaching 2-3 feet high by 3-4 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 7-9, shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Deep purple– maroon foliage.
- **Flower:** Pink string clusters in spring
