

Purple Pixie® Dwarf Weeping Loropetalum



Loropetalum chinense 'Peack' PP18441

- **Use:** A new dwarf, spreading Loropetalum, Purple Pixie™ boasts some of the most intense purple foliage color available on the market. An excellent groundcover for your garden. New flushes start upward and then gently cascade downward, creating a beautiful purple carpet effect.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full (best foliage color)— part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Growing to an average size of 1-2 feet tall by 3-4 feet wide. Prune to maintain height and shape yearly.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7a-10b, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Excellent burgundy color.
- **Flower:** Unusual clusters of pink, fringe flowers bloom year round. Heaviest flowering in spring, repeating throughout the year.
