Loropetalum chinense 'Snowmound' PP11766

- <u>Use:</u> A delightful, spring-blooming shrub with snowy white straplike flowers that cover the plant; has a compact, mounded habit and a moderate to slow growth rate; an easy to grow and wellbehaved shrub for general garden use
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun (More shade tolerant than other types of Loropetalum). Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- <u>Growth</u>: Dwarf type-growing to 12-14" tall and 2-3' wide. This is a relatively low maintenance shrub, and should only be pruned after flowering to avoid removing any of the current season's flowers. It has no significant negative characteristics.
- Hardiness: Zone 6b-10b, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. The oval leaves remain green throughout the winter.
- <u>Flower:</u> White, strap-like, petaled flowers that are abundantly produced in April as the new shoots emerge from the previous season's growth.
