

Indigo Flair Mahonia/ Grape Holly



Mahonia confusa 'Indigo Flair'

- **Use:** A compact evergreen with yellow flowers fall through winter that contrast against blue-green leaves. Excellent choice for an accent, in containers, borders or in mass plantings.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grow it in filtered sun or morning sun and afternoon shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** It is a rounded grower, maturing at 3 to 4 feet tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 7b-9; shrub Keep in a protected area near the home.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen The olive-green foliage of this shrub is elongated and widely-spaced, a threadleaf effect that works quite well against both flowers and berries. Has an Oriental look, making it a nice choice for Asian-themed gardens.
- **Flower:** It has attractive sprays of bright yellow flowers from its terminal buds each fall. These are followed by attractive blue berries.
