

Burgundy Wine Nandina



Neat mounds are terrific for massing, borders and containers. Requires no pruning.



Nandina domestica 'Burgundy Wine'

- **Use:** Vibrant red and green leaves throughout the season with very striking, narrow burgundy new growth. Outstanding red color in the fall. Neat mounds are terrific for borders, massing and containers. Requires no pruning.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil. Water may not puddle around plant, and appreciates slow release fertilizer twice a year. Water if it hasn't rained in 7-10 days first 2 years. Must amend the soil if you have red clay!
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing to 30 in. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-8; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Vibrant red and green leaves are narrower and finer than the species.
- **Flowers:** Creamy white flowers emerge from mid to late spring. It produces abundant white berries through fall and winter.
