Nandina domestica 'Harbour Dwarf'

- **Use:** Effective as a groundcover, specimen plant or border. Attractive, dense compact evergreen shrub displays brilliant burgundy foliage in fall and winter. Effective as a groundcover, specimen plant or border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Dwarf habit 1 to 2 ft. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-8 shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. The dark green, finely-textured, evergreen foliage turns to attractive maroon-red during winter.
- **Flower:** Just like it's parent, it produces panicles of white, star-shaped flowers in late spring or early summer.
