

Nandina Flirt



Nandina domestica 'Murasaki'

- **Use:** Has red new growth in spring, summer and autumn and goes red in winter. It is very drought, cold and humidity tolerant. Flirt™ goes almost completely red in winter. Excellent choice to plant in front of foundation shrubs.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Dwarf habit 1 to 2 ft. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-8 shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Stunning, deep red, new growth accentuates the evergreen leaves of this nandina. Superior color through the summer unlike similar varieties.
- **Flower:** Tiny white flowers in spring, but not noticeable.

**Used as a groundcover,
low hedge or a feature.**
