Plant in beds near a porch, as a screen or as an accent. Imagine a fragrant hedge, or a striking specimen - or plant in your perennial garden and bring back those memories of Grandma's garden!

Philadelphus lewisii x coronaries 'G15097' PP32770

- **Use:** This beauty not only offers smaller-space gardeners the chance to enjoy the beauty and transporting citrus scent of Mock Orange, it extends the blossom season it also flowers on old and new wood. This treasure produces large, fully double, intensely fragrant white flowers on upright branches from spring to fall. Site it near a screened-in porch, window, or door so the heavenly scent can waft in on a breeze.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers morning sun with shade from 2-3pm onwards in warmer locations (North of zone 7 can take all day sun). Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast grower to 4–5' high x 3–4' wide. It blooms on old wood, so any pruning you do wish to do should be done after flowering.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5a-8b Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Oval, dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Fragrant (citrus scented) double white flowers repeat bloom spring to fall.
