Great foliage stunner in the landscape. Good in groupings and mass planting, perennial and shrub borders. This is a very tough plant that is ideal for difficult sites.

Physocarpus opulifoliosus 'Mindia'

- **Use:** Attractive, copper-flushed spring foliage turns to rich burgundy red in summer. Soft pink flowers line the gently arching branches in early summer. Coppertina is also noted for its attractive peeling bark and bright red seed capsules in fall. An adaptable native plant that is easy-to-grow and well-suited for difficult sites.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 6 to 8 feet tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 6 -9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Coppery-orange foliage all season long.
- **Flower:** White flowers in early summer.
