Stately hedge or specimen tree. Can also be used in pots around the home for a few years.

Picea conica 'Glauca'

- **Use:** A perfect cone-shaped dwarf conifer displaying dense green needles which are soft to the touch. Excellent as a miniature Christmas tree in natural form, or as an artistically pruned topiary. Makes a formal statement in the garden. Superb container specimen.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. They need to be protected from summer sun in zone 7/8 so a little afternoon shade is preferred. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Slowly reaches 6 to 8 ft. tall, 4 to 5 ft. wide in natural form.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 2-8; Shrub Protect from summer sun in Zone 7/8.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Holds its foliage color throughout winter.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers..
