

Temple Bells Japanese Pieris



Pieris japonica 'Temple Bells'

- **Use:** Also known as Lily of the Valley Shrub. Fragrant! Compact rounded evergreen broadleaf shrub. Grows well in containers. Produces greenish berries in summer. Easy to prune. New growth emerges a vivid orange-red color. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Morning sun / afternoon shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Will tolerate more sun and drought after a few years of growth and establishment.
- **Growth:** Moderate, upright grower to 3 ft. tall, 3 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Fire-red new growth turns dark green when mature.
- **Flower:** Pendulous white flowers cascade from stem tips in spring.

Good for use in light shade woodland gardens. Fragrant!
