Japanese Mock Orange



Pittosporum tobira

- <u>Use:</u> Attractive upright form displays clusters of fragrant orangeblossom-scented white flowers backed by handsome glossy foliage. Small round fruit follows blooms. Useful as screens, mass plantings or individual accents. Very versatile and can be pruned to keep shorter. Good border, hedge or landscape accent.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate, compact grower to 6 to 8 feet tall and wide, larger with age. Can easily be kept 4' tall with pruning.
- Hardiness: 7-9, Shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen. Plants produce a dense mound of attractive lustrous green foliage.

• *Flower:* Creamy white flowers are small but have a terrific orange-blossom fragrance.
