

Wheeler's Dwarf Japanese Mock Orange



Pittosporum tobira 'Wheeler's Dwarf'

- **Use:** This shrub will form a low, compact mound of dark green foliage, but with age it can also be pruned to form a picturesque, miniature tree in a container. This plant is wonderful for the front of shrub borders, and it is ideal for patios and terraces.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established. Must have well drained soil. Sandy and salty soil tolerant.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 3 to 4 feet high, 3 to 4 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 7-9, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Plants produce a dense mound of attractive lustrous green foliage.
- **Flower:** The flowers are not noticeable, and this plant produces no fruit. This plant is considered mostly allergy free and causes little or no allergy problems in most people.
