## Podocarpus macropyllus 'Emerald Flame'

**Use:** This columnar shrub is excellent to flank front doors or to fill a tight corner. Can even be used as anarrow hedge that will tolerate some shade. A tough shrub in a low maintenance package, it offers disease, pest and deer resistance and tolerates full sun and heat. Evergreen with an upright habit, plant as hedge or accent.



Low maintenance • in a pot or used as a hedge. Upright • shrub; great as a privacy screen.

- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- *Growth:* Reaches 8-10' high x 3-4' wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 7a-11; Shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen. In spring new growth flushes a striking bright pink and then later matures to a deep green.
- *Flower:* Not known for flowers. 1 to 1.5 in. male catkin-like flowers occur in clusters; 0.5 in. edible purple-red fruit on female plants
