

# Stay Classy® Purple Leaf Sand Cherry



- **Dramatic coloring**
- **Matures quickly**
- **Useful mid-size habit for the border or for a low hedge.**

## *Prunus x cisterna* 'UCONNPCSDR' PP36173

- **Use:** Finally, a better purple leaf sand cherry! From Dr. Mark Brand at the University of Connecticut. It's also about half the size of conventional types, reaching a super-useful 3-4' tall and 4' wide. It bears pretty white flowers in spring, but this is really more of a foliage work-horse, equally suited to beautifying home and residential landscapes.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly to 3-4' high and 4' wide. Can be pruned to be kept shorter.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 2-8 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Red-purple foliage adds impact.
- **Flower:** Small, fragrant, white flowers in spring.
