

# Spring Sonata Indian Hawthorne

## *Rhaphiolepis x 'Delacourii Wilcor'*

- **Use:** Spring Sonata is in perfect tune with today's gardens. It offers dense growth, glossy green foliage, and a massive display of white flowers in spring. Spring Sonata blooms 2 to 3 weeks later than other Indian hawthorns, extending the bloom season in your garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 4 ft tall and 4-5 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** 7-10, shrub
- **Foliage:** The foliage is a very deep green and the leaves have a curled effect.
- **Flower:** The spring-summer blooms of this variety are a pink blossoms that open white than any other we have seen. Purplish-black fruit in fall.
