

# Oriental Pearl Hawthorne



Low-Maintenance • Large, White Blooms • Versatile Variety

## *Rhaphiolepis indica 'Parhap' / 'Oriental Pearl'*

- **Use:** Masses of large, white blooms appear in the spring on this low-growing, drought-tolerant plant, making it a must-have for any low-maintenance landscape. It requires no pruning and is not fussy about soils – truly a no fuss, no muss shrub.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Fairly drought tolerant. They do not like sprinklers, if you must use a sprinkler do so only in the morning. They prefer dry leaves.
- **Growth:** Rounded, 2–3' height x 2½–3½' width
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen Glossy green foliage looks neat year round.
- **Flower:** Small flowers are fragrant. White flowers in early spring through summer.
